

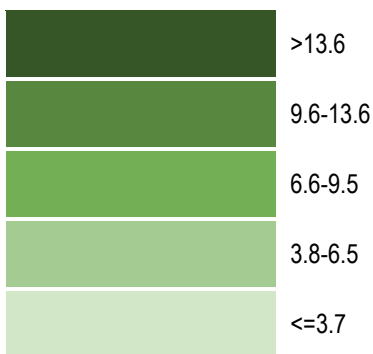
AEDI Mapping Colour Classifications -National Quintiles



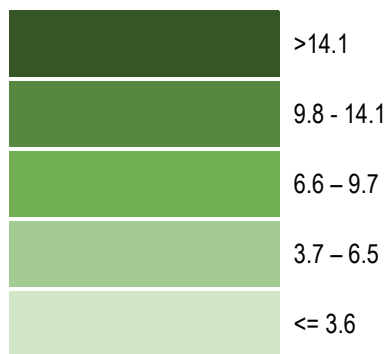
Per cent Developmentally Vulnerable

AEDI Local Communities are ordered from those with the highest percentage of developmentally vulnerable children to those local communities with the lowest percentage of developmentally vulnerable children. This list is then divided into five equal parts or quintiles (i.e. 0-20%, 20-40%, 40-60%, 60-80%, 80-100%). Each quintile is colour coded with the darkest quintile having the highest percentage of developmentally vulnerable children and the lightest green quintile having the lowest percentage of children developmentally vulnerable. For example, on the Social Competence domain, a community with the lightest shading of green has less than or equal to 3.6 per cent of children developmentally vulnerable.

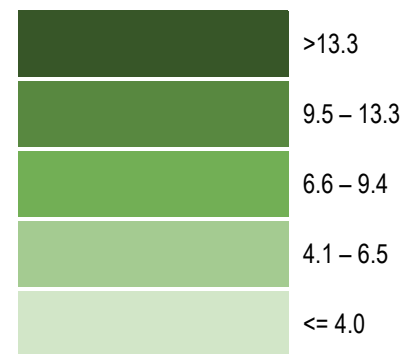
Physical Health and Wellbeing (%)



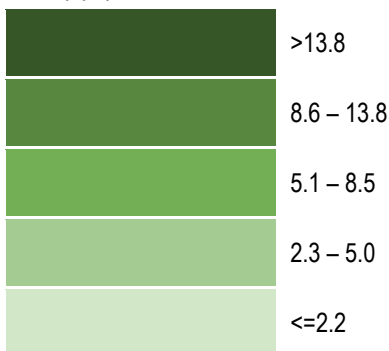
Social Competence (%)



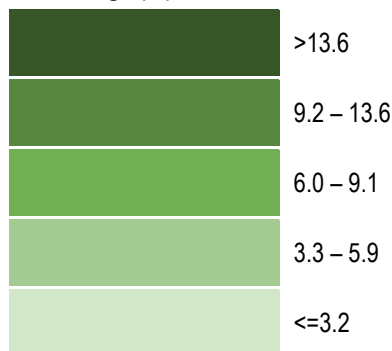
Emotional Maturity (%)



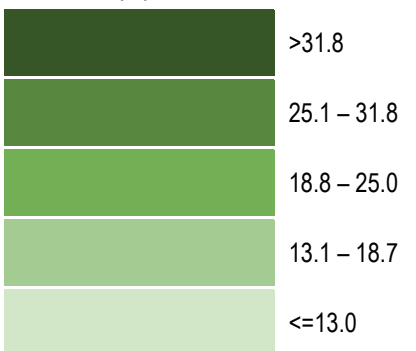
Language and Cognitive Skills (school based) (%)



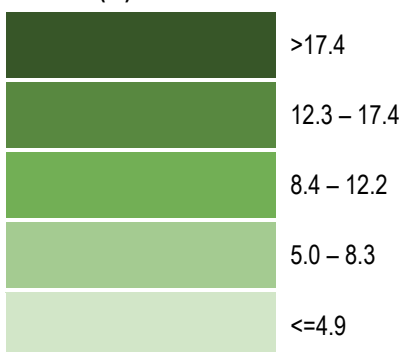
Communication Skills and General Knowledge (%)



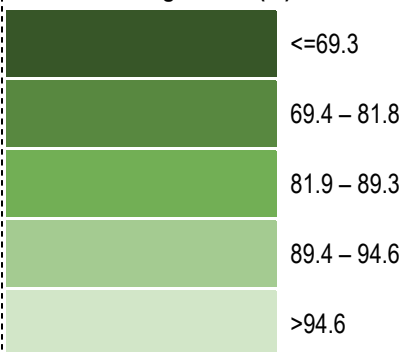
Developmentally vulnerable on one or more domain/s (%)
